About the Tutor: Kathleen Hunt teaches high school English at Cascia Hall. She holds degrees in English and Spanish from the University of Arkansas and a Master's degree in English from Oklahoma State University. She has five years of classroom teaching experience, including at the collegiate level and as a writing tutor in Oklahoma State University's writing center.
